Part-Time Youth Minister

Saint Thomas the Apostle Parish is actively seeking a spirit-filled Catholic to share the responsibilities of leading our Youth Ministry Life Teen Program. This position will work approximately 20 hours per week.

This person will be under the supervision of the Director of Youth and Parish Life Ministries and will work collaboratively, in a team, to minister directly to our youth as well as develop a core team of adult volunteers to help plan programs and activities that will immerse the young people in the life of the Parish, particularly through liturgy and sacraments, catechesis, prayer, service and community. Guided by the Holy Spirit, the team will seek to cultivate the soul of each young person by encouraging them to strive for purity, self-sacrifice, courage, and heroic love in their lives.

Job responsibilities for this position are: recruit, educate, train, lead, and inspire the youth core team, lead Life Teen Youth nights on Sunday nights, collaborate with the Parish Staff for events and trainings, and be a part of the leader team for the Steubenville Youth Conference.

We desire applicants who have previous experience working in youth ministry. In addition, it would be beneficial for candidates to either have, or be working toward, a Bachelor's Degree, preferably in Ministry or Theology, or a Certificate of Youth Ministry.
