Stage #1: Sponsor Research

The Gifts of the Spirit are Wisdom, Understanding Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Fear of the Lord, and Reverence. (Isaiah 11:1-5) We will learn more about these Gifts and their presence, activity, and power in our lives this year. Do you happen to know of anyone in your life who has a specific gift? Ask yourself if any of these people would qualify as a possible Confirmation Sponsor for you. You may list anyone you have in mind for this position. Most often Godparents, because of the close connection between the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, should be considered as Sponsors. Also for consideration would be other family members (except parents*), close family friends, youth ministers, faculty, coaches, etc. This is the beginning of the process.

Stage #2: Sponsor Qualifications

Now that you have some names of possible Sponsors, it is time look at the following information to determine whether they are appropriate for the Sponsor role.

Sponsor Qualification:

- must be a practicing Confirmed Catholic
- at least sixteen years of age (18 years & older is best)
- responsible and trustworthy
- prayerful, loving, and is comfortable sharing with the young person.
- positive attitude
- will support the parents in spiritually raising the young person in the Catholic Church for the rest of the young person's life.
- is able to attend the three monthly Candidate/Sponsor sessions ** on October 4/January 10/March 7

**Please note that according to Canon Law 874, a Sponsor cannot be the Candidate's mother or father. Also note: Candidates may select only one sponsor, unless the Baptismal Godparents are chosen.*

2. How will this person be a positive influence prayerfully and spiritually during your preparation process?
3. Will this person be able to commit to the Confirmation Sponsor Role?
4. What Gifts of the Spirit do you share with this person?
5. What do you most admire about this person's faith?

CONFIRMATION SPONSOR DECLARATION

Parent/s: Now that you and your child have discerned a qualified sponsor, please go forward with asking that person. When you do, share the reason why he/she was chosen and give the following details to assist him/her in making an informed decision.

Sponsor Duties:

The following is asked of the Sponsor:

1. Pray for and with the Candidate. Get to know the Candidate and lead them closer to Jesus Christ and His Church. Attend all or most of the three Candidate/Sponsor sessions (October 4/January 10/March 7).
2. Complete the assigned monthly online sessions.
3. Write a Recommendation Letter to the Parish Faith Formation Director stating that the Candidate is prepared for Confirmation, this is DUE in February. If you feel the Candidate is not ready for Confirmation, please call or email to discuss.
4. Present the Candidate during the Confirmation Mass. (late winter or early spring; the date will be announced in the fall)
5. Continue to be available for the Candidate to lend spiritual support after the Confirmation ceremony is over. This is a lifelong commitment!

Note: If he/she is unable or unwilling to fulfill the duties, return to the research process to discover another choice.

*** If a Sponsor cannot attend the Candidate/Sponsor sessions due to traveling distance, illness, or a calendar conflict, a proxy may be used. A proxy is a person who acts as a substitute in the sponsor's absence. A parent may act as a proxy. The proxy would be responsible to relay the missed information to the sponsor. This is only appropriate when all other options have been exhausted. Please remember that the monthly online Confirmation Candidate & Sponsor sessions are for building relationship and creating a bonding experience, as well as giving the Sponsors some of the needed tools for this lifelong journey with their Candidate.*
