We are Saint Thomas strong. For close to 100 years, we have partnered with our parents in the education of their children. We are an inclusive community, which makes our educational experience distinct.

Community defines who we are: a community of Catholic faith, a community of servant leaders, a community committed to innovative education. Our community shows value and respect towards all and rejoices in the gifts of others.



Over the last few years, we have heard from our parishioners, current, and prospective school families of a growing need for a **full-day preschool option**. Between 5 - 7 prospective families per year are unable to join us because of the absence of this full-day experience for their 3's, 4's or young 5's. Currently we have one preschool classroom and this year we are temporarily using the Ministry Center Community Room three mornings a week for our 3's preschool program.

To meet these increasing needs, space is required to begin offering **full-day programming**. God has blessed us with the building that will support our school families and our growing community with their child care needs.

Our Early Childhood program is licensed by the state of Michigan, ensuring a quality education in a healthy and safe environment for our littlest learners. Due to this licensing, we need three **larger classrooms** with enough square footage to accommodate **classes of 18 students each**. This will not only boost our enrollment, but also provide parents with a faith-based education right from the very start of their child's educational journey. This is a **true investment in their future and ours**. We **invite you to join us in this opportunity**.

Father Cusack and the Parish donate the land located at 1530 E. Fulton to Mercy Respite Care Corporation. Donations are solicited and the Respite Center is built.



The Center proves necessary and successful. The Parish donates 60 additional feet of land to expand the size of the building. Generous donors provide the funding.



Government funding for respite services is discontinued. The property is leased to Hope Network with restrictions that the building must be used for its original purpose of serving adults with disabilities.




The building and surrounding land are repurchased by Saint Thomas.

The Parish leases the building to Amanda (Winn) Barbour, who proposes her vision of what is now the Children's Healing Center, a safe play space for children with immunodeficient risks.


<u>Today 2024</u>
